Dating back almost 300 years, the estate beautifully combines the original rear wing, constructed in 1727, with the striking Georgian façade added around 1825, creating a residence that has stood proudly through generations of English history. Throughout its lifetime, the Hall has been home to influential families including the renowned Hollingworth and Hadfield families and even played a significant role during the Second World War, serving as a British Red Cross Hospital, adding yet another fascinating chapter to its remarkable story.

Despite its peaceful rural setting, Mottram Old Hall enjoys excellent accessibility. Located within the desirable village of Mottram-in-Longdendale, the property offers convenient access to the M67, M60 and wider motorway network, placing Manchester City Centre, Manchester Airport, Stockport, Glossop and the Peak District within comfortable travelling distance. Nearby stations at Hattersley, Broadbottom, Stalybridge and Glossop provide regular rail connections.

Set on the edge of the Peak District National Park, the area offers outstanding countryside, walking and cycling routes, reservoirs and attractions including Lyme Park, Etherow Country Park, Longdendale Trail and Werneth Low Country Park.

Families benefit from an outstanding selection of local schools, alongside respected independent schools including King's School Macclesfield, Terra Nova, Cheadle Hulme School and Manchester Grammar School.

Mottram, Hyde, Glossop and Stalybridge provide excellent everyday amenities, including independent cafés, restaurants, supermarkets, leisure facilities and boutique shopping.
